




Example from business:

Detail planning is replaced by a system for decision making on all levels in real time.




Agility - Reduce Uncertainty with Short Planning Horizon


Non-linear systems occur when 3 actors or more interact.

Characteristics:

- The future cannot be predicted.
- Small changes can have dramatic effects.
- Abrupt thresholds and long term stability.
- The system is not the sum of its parts.
- Patterns on macro level emerge from interaction on micro level.

The heart and command centre of a pulse organisation.

Here all work related to product development is visualised.

Strategic work such as customer segmentation and business goals as well as work done in projects and short assignments.

Everyone can see goals, plans, decisions, status on the pulse boards.


Each board is updated daily. The overall status in the pulse room is constantly changing to reflect the actual situation.

The pulse room has the ability to change and adapt with minimum restructuring cost.

The visualised information will guide actions for all people involved and channel the efforts in the right direction.


Decentralized Initiatives - Dividing the Business into Teams





An Agile Organisation for Strategy & Development Built on Pulse Meetings








